What is the A&B Crisis Fund?

The Catholic Children's Society's A&B Crisis Fund provides emergency support for families living in the Diocese of Arundel & Brighton. It provides grants to help families who are facing a crisis in their lives and have nowhere else to turn.

Our criteria is flexible in terms of how the funding can be used. However, to qualify the family must be facing exceptional circumstances where this one off support can make a meaningful difference to their lives. Sadly due to limited funds we cannot support ongoing needs.

How does it work?

We have a simple one page application form for Headteachers and Parish Priests to complete detailing the difficulties the family is experiencing and why they require this one-off financial support.

We aim to respond to all applications within 24 hours.

How is this funded?

We are only able to operate this fund thanks to the generosity of parishes, schools and individuals.

Every single penny donated to the A&B Crisis Fund is given out via emergency grants to support vulnerable families facing a crisis.
