*If I am in sorrow, my sorrow may serve Him.*

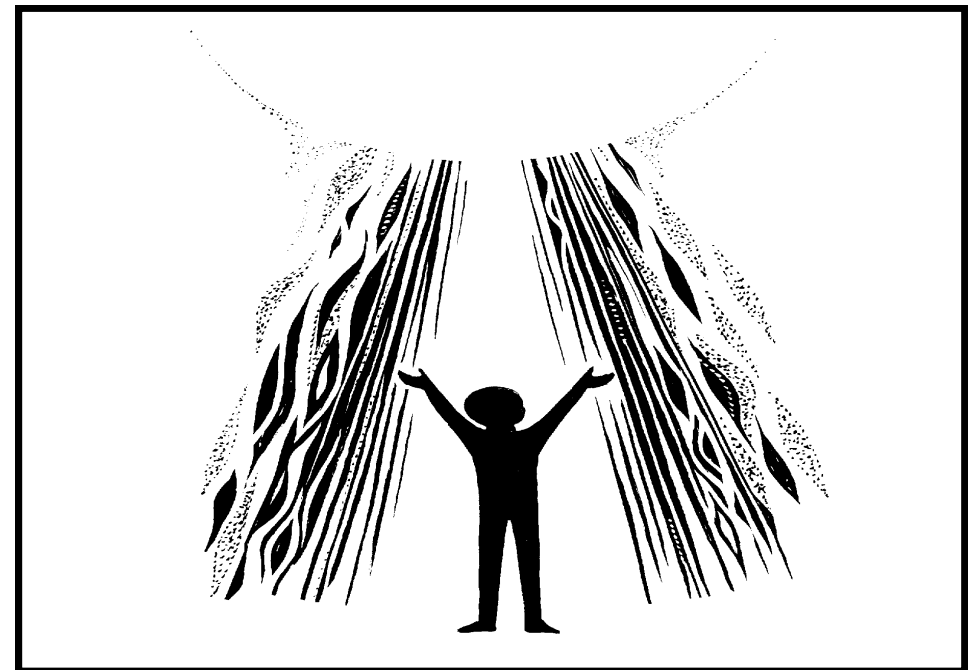
*He does nothing in vain.*
